Here are some questions to spark a discussion when reading at home with your child!

Why does the title make sense?

Why do you think the author wrote the story/book?

Who/What is the story/book mostly about?

Who is the main character (person or animal) in this story?

What is the main problem in the story?

How is the problem solved?

What is the setting of the story (where did it take place)?

What is one thing that happens to the main character?

How does the main character change from the beginning of the story to the end?

What happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story?

Name three things that you know about the main character.

Does the story/book remind you of any other books you have read?

Does the story/book remind you of anything that has happened in the world?

Does the story/book remind you of anything that has happened in your life?

Are there any characters that remind you of yourself or someone you know?

If you could add a page to the book, what would you write?

What is the most important thing to remember about the story/book?

Is this a non-fiction (about real things, people, events or places) or fiction (made up by the author) book?
